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1.0 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This Regulation applies to the product certification process in the mandatory sector of the European Directives

- **MACHINERY DIRECTIVE** - Directive 2006/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2006 on machinery and amending Directive 95/16/EC
- **NOISE DIRECTIVE** - Directive 2000/14/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 May 2000 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to the noise emission in the environment by equipment for use outdoors
as amended by COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2024/1208 of 16 November 2023

aimed at CE marking

- **MACHINERY DIRECTIVE** - of the following categories of machinery in Annex IV

1. Circular saws (single- or multi-blade) for working with wood and material with similar physical characteristics or for working with meat and material with similar physical characteristics, of the following types:

1.1. sawing machinery with fixed blade(s) during cutting, having a fixed bed or support with manual feed of the workpiece or with a demountable power feed;

1.2. sawing machinery with fixed blade(s) during cutting, having a manually operated reciprocating saw-bench or carriage;

1.3. sawing machinery with fixed blade(s) during cutting, having a built-in mechanical feed device for the workpieces, with manual loading and/or unloading;

1.4. sawing machinery with movable blade(s) during cutting, having mechanical movement of the blade, with manual loading and/or unloading.

2. Hand-fed surface planing machinery for woodworking.

3. Thicknessers for one-side dressing having a built-in mechanical feed device, with manual loading and/or unloading for woodworking.

4. Band-saws with manual loading and/or unloading for working with wood and material with similar physical characteristics or for working with meat and material with similar physical characteristics, of the following types:

4.1. sawing machinery with fixed blade(s) during cutting, having a fixed or reciprocating-movement bed or support for the workpiece;

4.2. sawing machinery with blade(s) assembled on a carriage with reciprocating motion.

5. Combined machinery of the types referred to in points 1 to 4 and in point 7 for working with wood and material with similar physical characteristics.

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6. Hand-fed tenoning machinery with several tool holders for woodworking.
7. Hand-fed vertical spindle moulding machinery for working with wood and material with similar physical characteristics.
8. Portable chainsaws for woodworking.
9. Presses, including press-brakes, for the cold working of metals, with manual loading and/or unloading, whose movable working elements may have a stroke greater than 6 mm and a speed greater than 30 mm/s.
10. Plastic injection or compression moulding machines with manual loading or unloading.
11. Injection or compression rubber moulding machines with manual loading or unloading.
16. Vehicle servicing lifts.
17. Devices for the lifting of persons or of persons and goods involving a hazard of falling from a vertical height of more than three metres.
19. Protective devices designed to detect the presence of persons.
20. Power-operated interlocking movable guards designed to be used as safeguards in machinery referred to in points 9, 10 and 11.
21. Logic units to ensure safety functions.

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This document is subject to specific approval by the Technical Committee of ENAVE S.r.l., subject to the favourable opinion of the Chairman of the Board of Directors, the Head of the Product Certification Body, the Technical Manager, the Head of the Product Certification Management System and the Impartiality Committee of ENAVE S.r.l..

The documented information on the ENAVE S.r.l. Product Certification Management System referred to in this document is an integral part of (and cannot be separated from) the ENAVE S.r.l. Product Certification Regulations.

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2.0 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ENAVE S.r.l.

ENAVE S.r.l. undertakes to carry out, with competence, objectivity, diligence, impartiality and professional integrity, the assessment of the conformity of its customers' machinery and equipment with the requirements of the standards and reference documents and, in the event of a positive outcome, to grant, as appropriate

- **MACHINERY DIRECTIVE** - Directive 2006/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2006 on machinery and amending Directive 95/16/EC
 - the issue of the EC TYPE EXAMINATION CERTIFICATE
 - the issue of the approval (approval) of the TOTAL QUALITY ASSURANCE SYSTEM
- **OND DIRECTIVE** - Directive 2000/14/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 May 2000 on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to the noise emission in the environment by equipment for use outdoors
as amended by COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2024/1208 of 16 November 2023
 - the issue of a REPORT confirming that the technical documentation meets the requirements of the Directive
 - the issue of a CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY confirming, through noise emission measurement tests, that the technical documentation prepared by the Manufacturer meets the requirements of the Directive

together with the maintenance, extension or renewal of the same documents and to provide for the inclusion of the customer's name and their machines or equipment in the list of certified products as indicated in the following documented information of the Management System for product certification of ENAVE S.r.l.

ENAVE S.r.l. shall be responsible for informing its customers of any significant changes affecting the validity of the product certification documents referred to in the previous period, in particular with regard to changes in their scope of application and the corresponding reference standards, in relation to the content of the following documented information of its Management System for product certification

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Unless otherwise specified in specific resolutions and/or Technical Circulars issued by ACCREDIA, the following activities must be carried out within the relevant timeframes for the management of transitions (of management systems):

Overall transition period	2 years from the date of publication (*) of the standard
ENAVE S.r.l. carries out assessment activities in relation to the new standard	3 months from the date of publication (*) of the standard
Affected customers must send ENAVE S.r.l. a specific declaration on the status of transition	6 months from the date of publication (*) of the standard
Completion of the transition by affected customers	9 months from the date of publication (*) of the standard
Performance of periodic audits by ENAVE S.r.l. exclusively in relation to the new edition of the standard	1 year from the date of publication (*) of the standard
Completion of the transition by organisations with product certification issued by ENAVE S.r.l.	2 years from the date of publication (*) of the new edition of the standard

(*) the date of publication is understood to coincide with the date of entry into force of the new standard

Therefore, within 2 years, conformity assessment documents with outdated standards must be withdrawn and reissued with references to the new standard.

During these 2 years, both product certifications are valid.

It is up to ENAVE S.r.l. to determine whether more time is needed by its client's organisation to verify the transition/migration and how to adapt the skills of its personnel involved in the conformity assessment process (internal and inspection).

ENAVE S.r.l. also considers, in the event of disputes with its clients, the following documented information from its Management System for product certification

ENAVE S.r.l. assumes no obligation regarding the positive outcome of the assessments conducted and, consequently, regarding the maintenance, renewal or extension of the documents issued following its positive conformity assessments.

ENAVE S.r.l. is responsible for verifying, within the limits of typical sample assessments, that its customers have the required skills (in terms of organisation, work/operating procedures and documents, human and instrumental

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resources) to carry out the CE marking of their products (machinery and equipment) in accordance with this document and any other relevant requirements.

ENAVE S.r.l. informs its customer in the following cases:

- request for transfer of accreditation ownership to a new legal entity following certain corporate transactions, such as:
 - change of company name;
 - merger;
 - incorporation;
 - transfer/lease of a business unit to another Conformity Assessment Body
 - etc.
- request for renewal of accreditation;
- request for extension of accreditation;
- suspension, revocation and reduction of accreditation or cessation of activities;
- complaints, reports, reservations and appeals;

communicating the outcomes and, in the event of a positive outcome, preparing and acknowledging what is deemed necessary and appropriate, on a case-by-case basis, for the correct and adequate management of the related consequences and corresponding repercussions.

ENAVE S.r.l. must include on the certificates issued under accreditation a reference to the applicable Technical Regulation (RT) of the scheme or sector, where applicable, using the wording:

"Certification issued in accordance with ACCREDIA RT Technical Regulation..."

(this obligation is prohibited if ENAVE S.r.l. is not yet accredited), with the exception of certifications issued abroad, where the application of the RT ACCREDIA requirements is optional unless they provide for the application of legislative or regulatory requirements (e.g. transposition of EA/IAF documents) applicable at international level.

ENAVE S.r.l. has full ownership and responsibility for the data relating to the certifications issued to its customers.

ENAVE S.r.l. is responsible for obtaining authorisation from its certified customers to transmit information relating to certifications to ACCREDIA, which in turn may publish this information on its website and, if already published, also transmit it to third parties (e.g. Chambers of Commerce, Research Institutes, CRIF, CERVED, ANAC, ENEA, IAF, ISTAT, Credit Institutions, etc.), even in their entirety and completeness, so that the recipients can in turn act as intermediaries for their disclosure to the public, when the same information has already been disclosed by ACCREDIA-DC.

ENAVE S.r.l. therefore remains solely liable to the entities using the service offered (e.g. ANAC, SOA, contracting companies, the market in general, etc. ...) and ACCREDIA-DC for any damage resulting from inaccuracies and/or untimely publication of data, thereby indemnifying ACCREDIA-DC from any liability, dispute or claim for damages in relation to such negligence or non-compliance.

ACCREDIA - DC: ACCREDIA Certification and Inspection Bodies Department

ENAVE S.r.l. is required to comply with specific procedures for the transmission of data relating to entities with product certification, which may be contained in specific instructions.

Any information relating in any way to the relationship between ACCREDIA-DC and ENAVE S.r.l. or to the relationship between ENAVE S.r.l. and certified/certifiable entities (ENAVE S.r.l. customers) must be kept confidential, i.e. ENAVE S.r.l. must not disclose it to third parties unless:

- publication is required by accreditation or certification rules;
- disclosure is required under these Regulations or is deemed necessary by ENAVE S.r.l. for the effective performance of its functions, but must be limited to the recipients of such disclosure;
- otherwise established by law or ordered by the judicial authorities;
- the request, with reasons, comes from another Accreditation Body that is a signatory to the EA or IAF MLA Agreements
- the disclosure is made with the explicit and unanimous consent of all parties concerned;
- the request is required by the rules defined by a Scheme Owner. In this case, ENAVE S.r.l. may need to share the contents of the assessment reports with the Scheme Owner.

ENAVE S.r.l. is required, in the event of revocation of a certificate, regardless of the reason for revocation (technical or administrative), if the certificate is to be reissued, to reissue it with a new date of current issue, even if the same certificate number and, where applicable, the same date of first issue are retained.

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ENAVE S.r.l. must initiate a formal and documented review if it becomes aware, through official documents or the press, of events attributable to its customers that reveal confirmed or suspected violations of laws relevant to the purpose of certification.

ENAVE S.r.l. must in any case inform ACCREDIA-DC.

It must also record adequate justification for any actions it intends to take.

ACCREDIA-DC may request further information and details, refraining in any case from requesting judicial data, as required by current privacy regulations.

ENAVE S.r.l. may subcontract activities to other Conformity Assessment Bodies accredited by ACCREDIA, informing its customer of this possibility.

ENAVE S.r.l. has established:

- a Technical Deliberation Committee, to which the requirements of UNI CEI EN ISO/IEC 17065 § 7.6 apply, supplemented by any specific rules defined by the relevant technical scheme/circulars;
- an Impartiality Committee, to which the requirements of UNI CEI EN ISO/IEC 17065 § 5.2 apply.

The documents or parts thereof specifying the rights and obligations of ENAVE S.r.l.'s customers and those of ENAVE S.r.l. must be made available to ENAVE S.r.l.'s customers before or at the time of signing the formal application for certification.

ENAVE S.r.l. must make general information available on the fees applied to applicants and customers in accordance with UNI CEI EN ISO/IEC 17065, § 4.6 b).

In order to carry out its certification activities, with reference to all the geographical areas in which it operates, ENAVE S.r.l. must be able to demonstrate that:

- it has assessed the risks arising from certification activities;
- it has taken appropriate measures (e.g. insurance or risk funds recorded in the balance sheet) to cover the professional risks of internal staff and collaborators (e.g. auditors, decision-making committees) arising from its activities, including in relation to the activities of its customers.

For mandatory/regulated areas where the stipulation of an insurance policy is required by regulations/laws, reference must be made to the requirements set out therein.

ENAVE S.r.l. must keep documents available to ACCREDIA-DC that constitute objective evidence of the absolute separation between certification activities and any consulting activities carried out by entities (natural and legal persons) connected to it in any way.

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This separation must be guaranteed in relation to every aspect and moment of the activities carried out by ENAVE S.r.l., starting from the definition of policies and guidelines, through the development of the entire certification process, up to the issuance, maintenance and renewal of certifications.

To this end, ENAVE S.r.l. must conduct an appropriate analysis of the associated risks in order to issue certifications guaranteeing the principles of competence, consistency and impartiality, documenting the results and justifying the conclusions drawn and the solutions adopted, with particular regard to issues related to the use of auditors also acting as consultants.

ENAVE S.r.l. must define risk indicators to be monitored/verified periodically in order to ensure that the level of risk is eliminated or minimised.

To this end, the Recommendations issued by the ACCREDIA Steering and Guarantee Committee in relation to the definition of uniform criteria for the verification of certain requirements of the UNI CEI EN ISO/IEC 17065 standard in the assessment and supervision of accredited Certification Bodies provide useful guidance.

The document issued by the CIG is used as a basis for developing the risk analysis document, or as a checklist for carrying out internal or external inspections.

Any proven violation of the above requirements will result in the adoption of sanctions by ACCREDIA.

As part of the certification scheme, ENAVE S.r.l. must keep all records relating to the activities carried out, including those outsourced/Performed externally (e.g. laboratories, audit/inspection companies, etc. ...), with particular reference to: execution times, characteristics of the sampling carried out, acceptance criteria adopted, accreditation status or qualification results of the laboratories used (with the exception of laboratories accredited by ACCREDIA), etc. ...

ENAVE S.r.l. must also keep available the documentation on the results of the verifications of compliance with the UNI CEI EN ISO/IEC 17025 standard carried out on non-accredited laboratories used in the certification scheme and provide evidence of the competence of the personnel employed for such verifications.

These verifications should preferably be carried out using a checklist that complies with the applicable requirements of ISO 17025.

This checklist must also be sent in advance to the Laboratory so that it can evaluate its use for its own internal inspections.

ENAVE S.r.l. is also invited to promote, for laboratories not yet accredited for the tests in which ENAVE S.r.l. is interested, a programme of accreditation, starting with laboratories that perform tests related to health, safety and environmental protection.

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With regard to the skills of the personnel involved in certification activities (internal file management functions and auditors), ENAVE S.r.l. must ensure, by defining the requirements and demonstrating compliance with them, that:

- staff meet the competence and/or experience requirements, where required by current legislation;
- staff have adequate knowledge of the products being assessed, including, where applicable, any critical issues related to their use, when this is known;
- staff have the necessary knowledge regarding the tests carried out, the analysis of the relevant results and their application for the purposes of conformity assessment ... *this involves, among other things, knowledge of sampling techniques, the validity and validation of test methods, and the management of uncertainties associated with the results.*

ENAVE S.r.l. customers undertake to maintain compliance with the applicable compliance requirements and to consistently behave in a manner inspired by fairness, transparency and collaboration with ENAVE S.r.l..

The customer of ENAVE S.r.l. must inform ENAVE S.r.l. if they are no longer able to meet the applicable requirements for compliance (of machinery and equipment) and, should any changes or complaints be recorded by the customer regarding compliance with product certification requirements, referring to the use of the following documented information from the ENAVE S.r.l. Product Certification Management System.

ENAVE S.r.l.'s customer undertakes to comply with all applicable safety requirements as provided for by the relevant legislation and to provide ENAVE S.r.l., during the planning of field assessment activities, detailed information on the prevention, protection and emergency measures adopted, by sending a report within 10 (ten) calendar days from the date of the inspection, except in cases of unscheduled surveillance, to which 7 (seven) working days apply.

ENAVE S.r.l.'s customer is required to promptly inform ENAVE S.r.l. of any pending legal proceedings concerning the activities covered by the conformity assessment of its machinery or equipment.

ENAVE S.r.l. customers are also required to promptly inform ENAVE S.r.l. of any administrative and legal measures relating to their internal and external personnel, again in relation to the activities covered by the conformity assessment of their machinery or equipment.

ENAVE S.r.l.'s customers must not transmit judicial data to ENAVE S.r.l., as required by current privacy regulations.

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4.0 REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE USE OF THE ENAVE S.r.l. TRADEMARK

Where ENAVE S.r.l. grants the manufacturer of the goods (machine or equipment) the use of its conformity mark through a licence, it is required to ensure that the mark is clearly and unambiguously related to the quality characteristics subject to assessment and certification and, where applicable, to the certification procedures (e.g. marks associated with surveillance).

Entities with product certification issued by ENAVE S.r.l. undertake to comply with the applicable requirements of these regulations.

The ENAVE S.r.l. product certification mark consists of the logo and name ENAVE - Ente Navale Europeo S.r.l..

The ENAVE S.r.l. mark, as a name and as an image and in every version provided for in these Regulations, is protected by specific registration in Italy and abroad, such as to guarantee its exclusive ownership by the Conformity Assessment Body for machinery and equipment for all uses and in relation to all parties.

The right to use the ENAVE S.r.l. trademark is granted to entities with certificates of conformity issued by ENAVE S.r.l. that have obtained product certification, as a result of which these Regulations are also deemed to have been accepted by the same entities, with the signing of the ACCEPTANCE CLAUSE on the last page.

The trademark or reference to product certification may therefore only be used by the legal entity that holds the product certification.

The granting of the right to use the ENAVE S.r.l. trademark includes authorisation for entities with product certification (where applicable) to grant their customers the right to use the ENAVE S.r.l. trademark, in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

By accepting these Regulations, entities with product certification:

- are authorised to refer to product certification, in the forms and manner indicated in these Regulations and in accordance with the requirements of applicable mandatory regulations;
- undertake to comply with the provisions of these Regulations when referring to product certification, even in the absence of the ENAVE S.r.l. mark;
- assume the responsibility of monitoring the correct use of the ENAVE S.r.l. mark by their customers/users of certified products (machinery or equipment).

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The granting of the right to use the ENAVE S.r.l. mark or reference to product certification, in accordance with the criteria set out in these Regulations, excludes the possibility of affixing the ENAVE S.r.l. mark on business cards and in emails of personnel (employees or collaborators) of entities with product certification.

A copy or sample of any document or object bearing the ENAVE S.r.l. trademark, as referred to below, must be kept available to ENAVE S.r.l. or provided upon request.

Entities with product certification must keep available to ENAVE S.r.l. and its Inspectors an adequate description of the uses of the ENAVE S.r.l. trademark that they envisage and regulate, including for their own customers, in accordance with these Regulations.

Entities with product certification are required to report to ENAVE S.r.l. any misuse or abuse of the product certification mark or logo of which they become aware.

Documents certifying conformity (certificates of conformity, inspection reports or validation and verification statements issued by ENAVE S.r.l.), within the scope of product certification, must bear the ENAVE S.r.l. mark, in accordance with the criteria set out in these Regulations.

The ENAVE S.r.l. mark shall be affixed to certificates of conformity, inspection reports or validation and verification statements in accordance with the graphic criteria established by ENAVE S.r.l..

The ENAVE S.r.l. mark may not be used on documents certifying conformity that do not relate to schemes accredited and managed by ENAVE S.r.l..

The ENAVE S.r.l. mark affixed to 'media' other than conformity attestation documents (e.g. commercial, promotional or advertising documents, letterhead, website, social media, etc.) ...) must comply with the above (i.e. complete with the logo, name and, where applicable, references to the certified schemes and the corresponding registration numbers of the product certifications issued by ENAVE S.r.l.).

The ENAVE S.r.l. mark may also be affixed to vehicles supplied to the customer with product certification issued by ENAVE S.r.l..

Where and when applicable, ENAVE S.r.l.:

- must explain to its customers the meaning and importance of Mutual Recognition Agreements (MRAs) between accreditation bodies at European and global level, for the purpose of recognising the quality of the products supplied by those customers on the international market;
- must also clarify, where necessary, the meaning of the terms (acronyms and abbreviations) used in reference to the MLA Agreements incorporated in the ACCREDIA Mark appearing on the certificates of conformity issued to the aforementioned customers and on other documentation exchanged with them.

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ENAVE S.r.l., in its relations with its customers, must not use the ACCREDIA Mark or any reference to accreditation in such a way as to create the impression that ACCREDIA accepts responsibility for the quality of the products, or for any opinion or interpretation that may derive from them, or that ACCREDIA gives any approval to a product.

ENAVE S.r.l. does not grant its customers the right to use the ACCREDIA mark following the certification of their products in the mandatory sector of European Directives aimed at the corresponding CE marking of the same; They are permitted to affix, in the immediate vicinity of the ENAVE S.r.l. mark (below, above or to the side), the wording (bilingual or monolingual):

Body accredited by ACCREDIA

Please note that further requirements relating to the use of the ENAVE S.r.l. mark on products may be contained in other applicable ACCREDIA documents (e.g. Technical Regulations RT).

The use of the ACCREDIA mark, the ENAVE S.r.l. mark, or the joint mark is not permitted in any type of technical documentation that may refer to the product in any way, when the ENAVE S.r.l. client organisation has a certified management system (e.g. declarations of conformity for CE marking, test certificates, etc.).

Violations of these Regulations by ENAVE S.r.l. customers, where applicable, will be sanctioned by ENAVE S.r.l. with the adoption of the following measures in ascending order of severity:

- written warning with a request to adopt the necessary corrections and corrective actions;
- in the event of failure to implement or inadequate implementation of corrections and/or corrective actions and/or persistence in the error: suspension of all product certifications held by the customer of ENAVE S.r.l., for a period commensurate with the seriousness of the non-compliance;
- in the event of persistent non-compliance and/or repeated violations beyond the end of the suspension period: revocation of all product certifications as above.

The ACCREDIA trademark and the ENAVE S.r.l. logo are protected by law and therefore their malicious or fraudulent use by ENAVE S.r.l. customers will be prosecuted in accordance with the law.

Notwithstanding the above, ACCREDIA and ENAVE S.r.l. reserve the right to report on their website any abuse or misuse of their logos/trademarks.
